





- Kamiah lies at an elevation of 1,240 ft in the Clearwater valley in Lewis County, Idaho.

- The town receives 28.33 inches of precipitation annually.



Inviting – The building especially the entry is reaching out to the community, while the inside has a warm and natural feel


Growth – The facility is spatially divided so that many different activities can take place at the same time without interupting each other

Controlled – The use of a lobby as a transition space allows for the visitor to directly access their intended destination without passing through multiple spaces


Protective – The use of transparency and spatial arrangment of offices within the building allows for sucessfull supervision




Spatial Arrangement





Site Plan







Bird's Eye Perspective






West Elevation







Lobby Floor Plan




Pool Enclosure Floor Plan








